

Pierce County Housing Authority provides housing assistance for over 2,500 low-income families throughout the Greater Pierce County community, primarily assisting those residing outside the city of Tacoma.

The Pierce County Housing Authority owns and manages approximately 670 units of affordable housing for moderate and low income families.

Generally the Board of Commissioners meet once a month on the last Wednesday of the month for approximately 1 ½ to 3 hours.

The Board of Commissioners is responsible for establishing policies for the Agency.
